


Nearly 9 out of 10 Seniors Are Satisfied with Medicare Part D

Each year Medicare Today conducts a nationwide survey to find out how seniors feel about their coverage of prescription medications through Medicare. This year, the Senior Satisfaction Survey found that beneficiaries' satisfaction with the coverage Part D provides has actually *increased* over the year, speaking to the program's consistent success among seniors.



- Two-in-three Part D enrollees said prescription drug plans should negotiate prices directly with the biopharmaceutical manufacturers instead of letting government set prices and determining which drugs will be covered under Part D formularies.
- 83 percent of seniors are concerned that federal involvement in pricing could reduce choice and options for prescription drugs for seniors and individuals with disabilities in the Medicare program.
- 82 percent of seniors are concerned government price setting policies would limit access to newer prescription medicines.
- 81 percent said it is important to them to have a variety of plans from which to compare and choose.

Methodology: This poll was conducted by Morning Consult, on behalf of Healthcare Leadership Council, between June 28-July 1, 2022 among a sample of 1,005 Senior Voters with Medicare. The interviews were conducted online. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 3 percentage points.
